

Homicide's grieving family saved from Orange County Government Fraud

Eddie Evans saves grieving family of homicide victim from Orange County Administrator's attempted fraud - - 22 September 2010

On Thursday, 22 September 2010, our author diverted an innocent family from a corrupt Orange County employee. Orange County Administration employee "Bob Mull" attempted to direct a family to an Orange County crime scene cleanup company.

Subjected to a high pressure sales gimmick, Orange County Administrator employee "Bob Mull," said to the grieving survivor, "You have one hour to clean it up after you get there."

He went on to say, "I want you to use this company," pointing to one of three companies with asterisks he placed next to company names. "Bob" then *directed the homicide survivor to sign for cleaning company fees* without disclosing costs or services.

I want to thank this family for contacting me. By doing so they helped to reveal more corruption among our Orange County Administration Department's employees. I will disclose information related to this potential fraud victim only to our Orange County District Attorney, an office that denies protection to tax payers from county employees.
